## This Is the Day!

“This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it” (Psalm 118:24). Every day—even a hard one—is a day to rejoice that God made you, that he made another day for you, that he makes you the object of his care, and that he has given you another day to do good to other people and to share his good news. And every Sunday is a day of special joy; in a special way it is the Lord’s Day and a day of reunion for the Lord’s family.

That call to praise in Psalm 118:24 means even more when we take a closer at its context. “The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone. This is the LORD’s doing; it is marvellous in our eyes. This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it” (Psalm 118:22-24).

The stone hadn’t become the cornerstone yet when the Psalmist wrote those words. The stone still hadn’t become the cornerstore when Isaiah later paralleled them. But God had a plan, and in his mind it was as good as done: “Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, ‘Behold, I am the one who has laid as a foundation in Zion, a stone, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone, of a sure foundation: ‘Whoever believes will not be in haste’” (Isaiah 28:16). Jesus’ time on earth was still more than 700 years in the future. But God’s plan was sure.

Now we “believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification” (Romans 4:25).

Jesus told a parable with which he identified himself as God’s beloved son, rejected by people who should have received him gladly. When Jesus made his point, he quoted Psalm 118:22 about the rejected stone becoming the cornerstone (see Matt. 21:42, Mark 12:10-11, Luke 20:17). Peter made the same point about Jesus with the same passage (Acts 4:11). The household of God, the church, is built on Christ Jesus the cornerstone (Eph. 2:20).

In Peter 2:4-8, Peter quoted Psalm 118:22 and Isaiah 28:16 when he said that Christians are people who come to Christ, “a living stone” (v.4). Today is a great day because Christ lives! He is the cornerstone of his church and of good life now and forever. Isn’t that marvellous?
